<p><b>Continuous learning that you can do at home:</b> Continue to encourage your child to count forwards and backwards in ones up to 20. Ask your child to add together 2 sets of objects such as 2 apples and 3 bananas. Encourage your child to order and recognise numbers up to 20. Encourage your child to write numbers to 20.</p>	<p><b>Focus of the week:</b> This week matching, sorting and comparing numbers and objects.</p>
