12 I have the right to be listened to, and taken seriously

We have the right to express our views, feelings and wishes. To achieve this, we will listen to the person who is speaking. Adults will ask us questions and give us time to think and express our views, feelings or wishes.



We have the right to express our thoughts and opinions. To respect this, we will say what we think and listen to others. Adults will give us time to think about our opinions and ideas.
