

Our Playtime Charter.

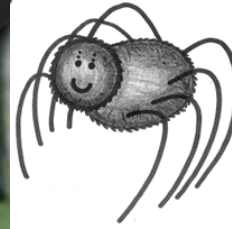


We have the right to be safe. To achieve this, we will have kind hands and use kind words. We will tidy away the toys when we have finished playing with them.



We have the right to be listened to. To respect this, we will ask for help if we need it, listen to adults and be polite. Adults will take time to listen carefully to what we have to say.

We have the right to be healthy. We will go to first aid if we get hurt, drink our milk and eat our fruit in the correct place. Adults will make sure fruit and milk is available every day.



We have the right to relax and play. To respect this, we will include others in our games. To help us, adults will make sure resources are available every day.

We have the right to be treated with respect and fairness. To achieve this, we will share the toys and resources, treat people fairly and equally and choose who we want to play with. Adults will help us find a friend, listen to everyone involved if we have a problem.
