

Stage 1:

- To develop a palmer grasp (holding a pencil/ crayon with the palm of their hand facing down towards the paper. The pencil/ crayon is held by all fingers and the thumb.)



Stage 2:

- To develop a four finger and thumb grip (Holding the crayon/pencil between the thumb and four fingers with the crayon/pencil nearly vertical up right position).



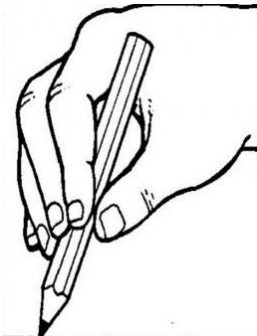
Stage 3:

To develop a modified tripod grip (Holding the crayon/pencil between the thumb and four fingers with the crayon/pencil nearly vertical up right position)



Stage 4:

- To develop a tripod grip (Holding the crayon/pencil between the thumb and four fingers with the crayon/pencil nearly vertical up right position)



Stage 5:

- To develop a mature tripod grip (Holding the pencil between the thumb and index finger with pencil supported on the middle finger. The ring and little fingers are gently curled inwards.)
