PE and Sport Premium Funding

2023-24 Report

We seek to continue our excellent provision of PE and sport by continuing to effectively use the additional funding provided to us. The impacts we are aiming for this academic year are to continue to get large percentages of children involved in both intra and inter school sport.

We also wish to seek to introduce children to new sports and run additional extra-curricular opportunities. We wish to embed good practice through further training.

Basis of allocation

The PE and Sport Grant for the 2023-2024 academic year is funded in two instalments in November 2023 (£10,261) and May 2024 (£7,329). Schools must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport they offer.

This means that the premium should be used to:


- develop or add to the PE and sport activities that the school already offers
- make improvements now that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years

Allocations for the financial year 2023 to 2024 are calculated using the number of pupils in years 1 and 2, as recorded in the January 2023 census, as follows:

- schools with 17 or more pupils receive £16,000 plus £10 per pupil

During this academic year our school received **£17,590** based on 159 children.

The table below details how we spent the money.
