This week the children will be making biscuits as part of their writing learning. The recipe uses the following ingredients;

Plain Flour

Butter (vegan spread)

Caster Sugar

We have taken into account allergies and dietary requirements but if you have any concerns or questions please reach out to your class teacher. The children will be doing this in small groups over the week starting from Tuesday.

Maths Activities:

Continuous learning that you can do at home:

Continue to encourage your child to count forwards and backwards in ones up to 20. Encourage your child to order, recognise and write the numbers up to 20. Practise spotting 2D and 3D shapes in the environment or using position and direction words as part of play.

Focus of the week:

The children will be exploring halving. They will experience halving shapes and numbers through stories and practical activities.

English Activities:

Phonics Focus:

To support the children in phonics they are working in small targeted groups with children that are learning the same sounds and phonological skills.



Focus of the week:

This week we will be looking at recipes and instructions. The children will have a go at verbally giving instructions for brushing their teachers teeth (hopefully they will remember what they learnt in the nurses assembly last week!) Throughout the week the children will work in small groups to make some biscuits. They will then have a go at writing a set of instructions so they can also make them at home.

Home Learning:

Thank you for your comments in the reading journals, we really appreciate it. It is recommended that the children read it at least 3 times to be able to practice all the relevant skills!
