Writing Focus:

This week the children are continuing their learning on 'Greta and the Giants'. The children are going to learn about different suffixes and practice applying these into sentences. They will then use all of their learning to write a character description about Greta.

Maths Focus:

During this week, some of the children will be continuing with multiplication and learning how to create an array. Other children will be moving on to division, using resources and pictorial representations to find the answers.
