Maths

- Can you count in multiples of 2, 5 or 10?
- Practice finding pairs of numbers to total 10, 20 or 100
- Spend some time on numbots and TT rockstars (logins in reading journals)

Reading

- Can you find and read a story, a set of instructions, a comic?
- Retell stories using key language- this can be verbally or through story maps

Writing Focus:

In writing this week the children will be writing their non-chronological report about their made up animal. We will be finding out some facts about their two chosen animals to create their report.

Maths Focus:

During the week, some children will be exploring capacity and the language around this. Some children will carry on with mixed multiplication and division.
