<p>Continuous learning that you can do at home:</p> <p>Continue to encourage your child to count forwards and backwards in ones up to 20. We will be thinking about length, height and weight in the context of Christmas.</p>

<p>Phonics Focus:</p> <p>The children are now grouped across mixed class groups within Early Years.
