Continuous learning at home for this half term:

Maths

- Practice writing numbers in words from 0 to 50/100
- Can you draw an empty number line and estimate where different numbers will go on it?
- Can you count in multiples of 2, 5 or 10?
- Practice finding pairs of numbers to total 10, 20 or 100
- Spend some time on numbots and TT rockstars (logins in reading journals)

Reading

- Sit and snuggle with your favourite book and try and discuss what the characters were doing in it
- Can you find and read a story, a set of instructions, a comic?
- Retell stories using key language- this can be verbally or through story maps

Writing Focus:

During this week, we will be exploring the text 'The Royal Baby Big Red Bus'. The children will immerse themselves into a character in the book and to write a speech bubble.

Maths Focus:

This week we will continue our learning about addition and subtraction. They will look at a variety of different methods, using concrete resources and number lines. The children will explore the language used when solving problems around addition and subtraction.

A plea from us:

Our Design and Technology this half term will be focusing on weaving. In preparation for this, we would like to ask for donations of any off-cuts of fabric. These off-cuts need to be larger than 30cm to allow for the weaving. Please bring these to your child's class by Monday 26th January. Thank you.

Important information...
