**Key Information:**

We are reading with your child weekly to build on their phonics learning. Please ensure your child's reading journal is in their book bag every day.

**Maths Activities:**

<p><b>Continuous learning that you can do at home:</b></p> <p>Continue to encourage your child to count forwards and backwards in ones up to 20. Ask your child to add together 2 sets of objects such as 2 apples and 3 bananas. Encourage your child to order and recognise numbers up to 20. Encourage your child to write numbers to 20. Ask your child to create their own repeating patterns using items from around your home e.g. fruit, clothing, toys etc</p>	<p><b>Focus of the week:</b></p> <p>This week we will exploring 3D shapes. We will be looking at which 2D shapes faces can be seen on them.</p>

<p><b>Phonics Focus:</b></p> <p>The children are now grouped across mixed class groups within Early Years. They will be learning Orange and Pink Phase at varying paces.</p> <p>Ask your child which adult they have for this and don't forget to check their book bag for phonics booklets to see what they have been up to.</p>	<p><b>Focus of the week:</b></p> <p>This week in writing we will looking at the adventures of Mr Benn and adapting his adventures.</p>
