| <p><b>Maths</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Practice writing numbers in words from 0 to 50/100</li><li>• Can you draw an empty number line and estimate where different numbers will go on it?</li><li>• Can you count in multiples of 2, 5 or 10?</li><li>• Practice finding pairs of numbers to total 10, 20 or 100</li><li>• Spend some time on numbots and TT rockstars (logins in reading journals)</li></ul> | <p><b>Reading</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Sit and snuggle with your favourite book and try and discuss what the characters were doing in it</li><li>• Can you find and read a story, a set of instructions, a comic?</li><li>• Retell stories using key language- this can be verbally or through story maps</li></ul> |
