Key Information:

This half term our topic is Amazing Adventures as part of this we will be having a pirate day! This will be an opportunity for your child to dress up as a pirate for the day! Pirate day will be on **Monday 2nd February**.

Maths Activities:

<p>Continuous learning that you can do at home:</p> <p>Continue to encourage your child to count forwards and backwards in ones up to 20. Ask your child to add together 2 sets of objects such as 2 apples and 3 bananas. Encourage your child to order and recognise numbers up to 20. Encourage your child to write numbers to 20. Ask your child to create their own repeating patterns using items from around your home e.g. fruit, clothing, toys etc</p>	<p>Focus of the week:</p> <p>This week we will looking at growing our knowledge of 9 and 10. We will be recognising the different ways of making the numbers as well as looking at the different representations.</p>
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English Activities:

<p>Phonics Focus:</p> <p>The children are now grouped across mixed class groups within Early Years. They will be learning Orange and Pink Phase at varying paces.</p> <p>Ask your child which adult they have for this and don't forget to check their book bag for phonics booklets to see what they have been up to.</p>	<p>Focus of the week:</p> <p>This week in writing we will be exploring Pirate Pete and adapting his adventures. The children will be creating their own adventure time for Pirate Pete by designing our own boat and other characters on his journey.</p>
