Discuss surroundings and give instructions using mathematical vocabulary. Continue to encourage your child to count forwards and backwards in ones up to 20. Encourage your child to order and recognise numbers up to 20. Encourage your child to write numbers to 20.</p>	<p>Focus of the week: Our focus in Maths will be shape and space, including positional and directional vocabulary.</p>

<p>Phonics Focus: The children are now grouped across mixed class groups within Early Years. They will be learning Orange and Pink Phase at varying paces.
