Week beginning: Monday 29th September

Continuous learning at home for this half term:

Maths

- Practice writing numbers in words from 0 to 50/100
- Can you draw an empty number line and estimate where different numbers will go on it?
- Can you count in multiples of 2, 5 or 10?
- Practice finding pairs of numbers to total 10, 20 or 100
- Spend some time on numbots and TT rockstars (logins in reading journals)

Reading

- Sit and snuggle with your favourite book and try and discuss what the characters were doing in it
- Can you find and read a story, a set of instructions, a comic?
- Retell stories using key language- this can be verbally or through story maps

Writing Focus:

After finishing our first unit of Jack and the Beanstalk, we will be exploring another version of the story, Jack and the Meanstalk. During this week, the children will retell the story through role play, before focusing on required punctuation within a sentence and conjunctions. They will end the week by thinking about what makes a good friend.

Maths Focus:

We are continuing our focus on number and place value. During the week the children will be representing numbers on a number line and comparing numbers. The children will apply their knowledge of tens and ones to support them as well as their counting knowledge.

Important information...

For PE, KS1 will be going outside for as much of the year as possible. Please ensure your child has a winter PE kit consisting of navy blue jumper / hoody and jogging bottoms / leggings and trainers alongside their indoor / summer PE kit of red shorts & white t-shirt. Thank you!
