Continuous learning at home for this half term:

<p>Maths</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Practice writing numbers in words from 0 to 50/100• Can you draw an empty number line and estimate where different numbers will go on it?• Can you count in multiples of 2, 5 or 10?• Practice finding pairs of numbers to total 10, 20 or 100	<p>Reading</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sit and snuggle with your favourite book and try and discuss what the characters were doing in it• Can you find and read a story, a set of instructions, a comic?• Retell stories using key language- this can be verbally or through story maps

Writing Focus:

During Writing this week, the children will be introduced to our theme of the half term, fairy tales. The children will begin by exploring views that Jack would have experienced along with exploring nouns and ways to improve them to help with imagery. The children will then look at ways that they can retell the story.

Maths Focus:

We are starting the year focusing on number and place value. The children will be practicing their counting, subitising and writing of numbers, as well as identifying the place value within numbers (tens and ones) and counting in steps of a number.
